

Shoeing TP Horseshoes

1. Choose your model and open or closed configuration.



2. If an open shoe is chosen, remove bar with cutting tool.



3. Mark excess material by placing shoe on trimmed hoof.



4. Grind away excess material.



5. Apply our pins or studs, according to your needs.



6. Get the "white line" distance.



7. Drill on the markers at noted distance.



8. Apply nails as with any horseshoe.



9. Push nails deep with a tool.
